I. Duties

- E. Supervises nursery care attendants.
- F. Recruits, trains, and leads church volunteers working in children's ministry.
- G. Works to maintain a safe, warm, and nurturing environment for all children and youth and ensures compliance with the United Methodist Church's Safe Sanctuaries directive.
