

This year's theme is "Hero Hotline: Called together to serve God." All kids ages 4-11 are welcome!






Covenant Class Sundays, 6 PM on Zoom

The ReOpening Task Force met on March 16 and voted to:

- Change the indoor mask requirement to a recommendation: "Masks are strongly recommended for indoor in-person FUMCPA activities, including worship."
- 2. Allow small groups meeting at church to establish their own

policies for mask use within the group.

3. Strongly recommend, but no longer require, masks during office hours Monday - Friday 9AM - 4PM, for visitors, vendors, and others who enter the facility.

The task force will meet again in the fall to evaluate circumstances at that time (with some experts predicting a "Covid season"); or should there be significant changes in Covid hospitalizations, new variants, or new interventions by the City, County or State in the interim.
